Subject: New Right-Of-Way (ROW) Utilization Permit Application Fees

Dear Valued Customers:

At their regular meeting held on May 10, 2016, the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners amended Chapter 24 "Roads and Bridges", Article 1 of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County. In partial, the Ordinance (2016-8) provides an updated Right-of-Way Utilization Permit Application form, Indemnity Agreement as well as adopted a new fee schedule, effective Tuesday, May 16, 2016.

A standard automatic processing fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) has been implemented in addition to the new fee schedule as follows:

Pavement Cut	\$100.00 each	Landscaping	\$ 50.00
Unpaved Cut	\$ 30.00 each	Driveway Apron	\$ 50.00
Jack & Bore	\$ 50.00 each	Utility	\$ 50.00
Directional Bore	\$ 30.00 each	Mailbox Installation	\$ 50.00
Subdivision Sign	\$ 50.00 each	Culvert	\$ 50.00
Communication Tower	\$ 50.00 each	Other (i.e, sinkhole remediation)	\$ 50.00
Power Pole Relocation	\$ 20.00 each		

Additionally, should the proposed work have the potential to interfere with future road constructing plans, MPO plans or transportation aspects of the Hernando County Comprehensive Plan or if the proposed structure may impact drainage projects, utility projects, planned sidewalks, bike path/lanes, as well as current or existing pedestrian/bike trails or future signalization of roads, the Hernando County Department of Public Works may, at their discretion, require a more detailed development review.

We have attached a copy of the revised Right-of-Way Utilization Permit application and associated indemnity agreement (required), as well as a copy of Ordinance 2016-8.
