UNIFORM WATER USAGE CHARGE FOR FLUSHING & PRESSURE TESTING

POLICY NO. 23-02

PURPOSE: It is the purpose and intent of the

Utility Department to establish a uniform policy of providing water for the purpose of flushing and pressure testing of water and sewer lines. This policy is adopted to alleviate the considerable confusion and inequity in determining a viable

charge for this service.

POLICY: It will be the policy of the Hernando County Utilities Department to require all contractors, developers, or individuals requesting water for this purpose to make the necessary arrangements for this

service.

1. FEES

The fees will be based on the capacity of the system to be tested in gallons, multiplied by three (3). Laterals are

excluded.

2. RATES

WATER: All customers to be billed at \$2.00/thousand

gallons based on capacity multiplied by three (3), or a minimum charge of \$7.50, whichever

is greater.

SEWER: Water for flushing sewers will be computed the

same as for water, except where the water is allowed to flow into an approved County system there will be an additional fee of \$4.00/1.000 gallons or a minimum charge of \$7.50, whichever is greater, for treating or

disposing of same.

FIRE HYDRANTS:

All water withdrawals from fire hydrants will be metered by the County for this purpose; the rate being the same as previously stated.

BILLING: The person requesting the service will be

responsible for payment to the Hernando County Utilities Department. All requests for service must contain the correct billing address of the firm or individual requesting same.
