

**REPAIR OF DAMAGE TO HERNANDO COUNTY
UTILITIES DEPARTMENT PROPERTY**

POLICY NO. 23-03

PURPOSE:

To insure uniformity when charging organizations, individuals, firms, etc., for repairing damage to Hernando County Utilities Department's property under this policy.

POLICY:

It is the policy of Hernando County to charge all persons, firms, or associations who damage Hernando County Utilities Department's property, including but not limited to, water lines, sewer lines, valve boxes, meter boxes, water and wastewater facilities, lift stations, fire hydrants, vehicles, construction equipment, wells, and buildings. The rates to be charged shall be as follows:

EQUIPMENT: FEMA's (Federal Emergency Management Agency) current Schedule of Equipment Rates.

LABOR: Actual hourly rate + Benefits.

MATERIALS: Actual Costs + 25%.

WATER LOSS: Commercial Usage Rate from 0-10,000 gallons

This policy shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
