### Medicaid for Aged or Disabled

Medicaid is not only for children or families with children. Low-income individuals who are aged (65 or older) or disabled are potentially eligible for Medicaid under SSI–Related Medicaid Programs.

Individuals may apply for regular Medicaid coverage and other services using the online ACCESS Florida Application at <a href="https://www.myflorida.com/accessflorida">www.myflorida.com/accessflorida</a>.

If *long-term* services in a nursing home or community setting are needed, the individual can also apply online but must check the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)/Waivers or Nursing Home selection. HCBS/Waiver programs provide in home or assisted living services that help prevent institutionalization.

Medicare Saving Programs (Medicare Buy-In) help Medicare beneficiaries with limited finances pay their Medicare premiums and in some instances, deductibles and co-payments. Medicare Buy—In provides different levels of assistance depending on the amount of an individual's or couples income. Individuals may apply for Medicare Buy In coverage by completing a paper Medicaid/Medicare Buy-in Application or online.

Individuals eligible for Medicaid or a Medicare Savings Program are automatically enrolled in Social Security Extra Help with Part D (Low Income Subsidy) benefit. You may also apply for Extra Help directly with Social Security at <a href="https://www.ssa.gov/benefits/medicare/prescriptionhelp">www.ssa.gov/benefits/medicare/prescriptionhelp</a>.

Those who are not eligible for "full" Medicaid because their income or assets are over the Medicaid Program limit may qualify for the *Medically Needy Program*. Individuals enrolled in Medically Needy must have a certain amount of medical bills each month before Medicaid is approved. This is known as a "Share of Cost" and varies depending on the household's income and size. Once an individuals meets their share of cost for the month, they must contact DCF to complete bill tracking and approve Medicaid for the remainder of the month.

#### HOUSING AND SHELTER



Habitat for Humanity offers low-income families the opportunity to own a home. Becoming a Habitat homeowner requires commitment, responsibility and deep involvement.

In order to partner with Habitat for Humanity, you must meet the following preliminary criteria:

- 1. You must be a Legal Permanent Resident of the United States.
- 2. You must have lived or worked in our county for at least 12 months. Affiliates for other vicinities can be found at habitat.org.
- 3. Your yearly income must fall within our income guidelines, which are adjusted for family size (refer to Income Table on the Selection Criteria page). Income includes wages, Social Security, disability, SSI, TANF and child support.
- 4. You must have one year of continuous income.
- 5. You must have a reasonably good credit history. It must be at least two years since you discharged any bankruptcies, and you must be making payments on your debts.
- 6. You must have a need for housing because your current housing is unaffordable, unsafe, or overcrowded.
- 7. You must partner with Habitat for Humanity and contribute "sweat equity," helping to build your home as well as other families' homes, and attend a minimum of 10 educational workshops.

# **Coverage for Florida Children**

Florida children from birth through the end of age 18 are eligible for coverage. It is free to apply and with year-round enrollment, the time to apply is always now.

Based on the age of the child, household size, and family income, we automatically match each child with their best fit of the four (4) Florida KidCare programs – Medicaid, Medikids, Florida Health Kids, or the Children's Medical Services Managed Care Plan.

Florida KidCare includes free, subsidized, and full pay options based on family income and household size. Most families pay nothing at all and many pay as little as **\$15** or **\$20** a month for all children in the household. Families who do not qualify for free or subsidized coverage may purchase a competitively priced full pay plan.

- Immunizations
- Vision and Hearing
- Prescriptions
- Dental Care

#### U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development-VA Supportive Housing (HUD-VASH) Program



HUD-VASH is a collaborative program between HUD and VA combines HUD housing vouchers with VA supportive services to help Veterans who are homeless and their families find and sustain permanent housing.

Through public housing authorities, HUD provides rental assistance Through public housing authorities, HUD provides rental assistance vouchers for privately owned housing to Veterans who are eligible for VA health care services and are experiencing homelessness. VA case managers may connect these Veterans with support services such as health care, mental health treatment and substance use counseling to help them in their recovery process and with their ability to maintain housing in the community. Among VA homeless continuum of care programs, HUD-VASH enrolls the largest number and largest percentage of Veterans who have experienced long-term or repeated homelessness. As of Sept. 30, 2015, HUD had allocated more than 78,000 vouchers to help house Veterans across the country.


