Pursuant to Section 163.3184(4), Florida Statutes (FS), please find the enclosed material relating to a proposed 2040 Comprehensive Plan for Hernando County.

Hernando County is submitting the proposed plan to the Division of Community Planning and the Review Agencies to be processed under the state coordinated review process as described in Section 163.3184(4) FS.

The proposed amendment and related background data and analysis have been available for public review at the Hernando County Planning Department. Review materials have also been posted on Hernando County's internet web page.

The following information is provided to fulfill the requirements of Section 163.3184(4) FS:

- 1) The proposed amendment is related to an updated comprehensive plan for Hernando County. Please note that documentation supporting the current comprehensive plan which was previously submitted is still valid to the extent that it supports the updated comprehensive plan.
- 2) The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) acting as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) and the Governing Body held an advertised public hearings on December 12, 2017, January 23, 2018 and March 6, 2018. The BCC and LPA voted to authorize transmittal of the enclosed proposed 2040 Comprehensive Plan to the State Land Planning Agency and other Review Agencies for comment on March 6, 2018

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- 3) The 2040 Comprehensive Plan for Hernando County updates the text of all elements of the comprehensive plan, reformats the plan approach to identify strategies to accommodate expected growth, resets the planning horizon to 2040, consolidates the Plan to 11 elements, retains the Future Land Use Map pattern, eliminates the Education Category from the Future Land Use Map, specifies that public schools are allowed in all Future Land Use Map categories, and updates the Map series included in the plan document.
- 4) The proposed month of adoption of the proposed comprehensive plan amendment (CPAM-17-02 Hernando County Board of County Commissioners) is June of 2018.
- 5) The proposed 2040 Comprehensive Plan for Hernando County is not applicable to an area of Critical State concern.
