



TAMPA VETERANS JOB FAIR

RecruitMilitary wants to make sure veterans and active duty military members can find good paying civilian jobs. The organization is teaming up with Disabled American Veterans to host a job fair at Amalie Arena in downtown Tampa on Thursday, July 19th. Hundreds of veterans, military members, guardsmen, reservists and their spouses are expected to attend the event."

Dozens of people who participated in previous RecruitMilitary job fairs in Tampa ended up receiving job offers.

Some recruiters are looking to fill immediate openings while other are searching for candidates for jobs that are not available right now, but will be opening up soon.

The Job Fair will take place on the Promenade Level Concourse. Enter the stadium from the plaza. Take the Grand staircase to Gate A. Those who require ADA accommodations should go to the Premium Assistance gate prior to the Grand staircase.
