

MCKINNEY-VENTO HOMELESS AS-SISTANCE ACT/STUDENTS AND FAMILIES IN TRANSITION

McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act is the primary federal legislation addressing the education of children and youth experiencing homelessness in U.S. public schools.

Under the McKinney-Vento Act all Local Education Agencies (LEA) must provide specific services to homeless youth.

Definition of Homeless:

According to the federal law, McKinney-Vento Act, children and youth are considered homeless if they lack a fixed, regular, adequate night-time residence:

- Any student who is sharing the housing with others due to economic hardship, job loss, eviction/foreclosure or any similar circumstances;
- Any student who is living in cars, trailer parks, campgrounds, public spaces, abandoned buildings or substandard housing;
- Any student who is living in hotels or motels;
- Any student who is living in an emergency or transitional shelter, a student who has been abandoned in a hospital;
- Any student who is an unaccompanied youth (not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian) in any of the above mentioned circumstances;
- Migratory children who are living in any of the above mentioned circumstances.

Children and youth rights and services

Every child has a right to a free and appropriate public education and is required to attend school regularly. Children and youth who fit the federal definition of homelessness under the McKinney-Vento Act have the right to:

- Immediate school enrollment and attendance, even without birth records, school records, immunizations, and/or health physicals;
- Remain at their school of origin or enroll in their neighborhood school for the duration of the academic school year;
- Transportation to and from school, if feasible; and
- Receive free breakfast and lunch during the academic school year.



Crescent Community Clinic Host Healthcare Day for the Homeless

On **October 17**, **2018**, the International Day for the Eradication of Poverty, **Crescent Community Clinic** will host a healthcare day for homeless adults 18 to 64 who have a chronic health condition or a mental health diagnosis. Individuals living in local homeless camps will be offered bus to-

kens to take the **BUS** to the clinic at **no cost**. They will receive blankets, toothbrushes, toothpaste, toiletries, and a boxed lunch. Return tokens will be provided at the Clinic.

AmeriCorps VISTA members is coordinating the event and invite other organizations to participate. Their goal is that all the homeless in our community will have access to *free healthcare*.

Crescent Community Clinic's mission is to provide access to healthcare for the uninsured, indigent, and under-served adults in Hernando County. All of the licensed providers and support staff are volunteers.



Volunteer Opportunity to Help Local Veterans

If you have a desire to help the veterans of Hernando County consider becoming a volunteer van driver. The Hernando County Veteran Services Department is in need of three drivers to transport disabled veterans to and from James A. Haley VA Hospital located at 13000

Bruce B. Downs Boulevard in Tampa. The van runs Monday through Friday, but not on Federal holidays.

Veterans are picked up at two designated locations:

Wal-Mart located at 7305 Broad Street in Brooksville and

Brooksville VA Outpatient Clinic located at 14540 Cortez Boulevard in Brooksville

Requirements to be a van driver:

- Possess a valid driver's license
- Have a safe driving record
- Maintain current automobile insurance proof of insurability
- Pass physical health screening in relation to driving vehicles
- Pass TB skin test
- Attend volunteer training orientation
- Desire to help the veterans of Hernando County

Vans are limited to eight passengers, plus driver. Pickups normally begin at 6:30 a.m. at designated locations. The van departs from Tampa no later than 2 p.m. Volunteer drivers will alternate shifts.




