



Pet “GO BOX” CHECKLIST



Emergency Supplies: Evacuations are more common than many people realize, each year transportation and industrial accidents release harmful substances, forcing people to leave their homes. Fires and floods cause evacuation even more frequently. And almost every year people along the Gulf and Atlantic coasts evacuate in the face of approaching hurricanes. When community evacuations become necessary, local officials provide information to the public through the media.

Keep emergency supplies handy for your pets. Make sure that everyone in the family knows where it is. This kit should be clearly labeled and easy to carry.

Recommended “Go Box” contents:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Photocopies of vaccination records and a waterproof container with a two-week supply of any medicine your pet requires (Remember, food and medications need to be rotated out of your emergency kit)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pet first-aid kit and guide book (ask your vet what to include)
<input type="checkbox"/>	3 to 7 days-worth of canned (pop-top) or dry food (be sure to rotate every two months)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Disposable litter trays (aluminum roasting pans are perfect)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Litter or paper toweling
<input type="checkbox"/>	Liquid dish soap and disinfectant
<input type="checkbox"/>	Disposable garbage bags for clean-up
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pet feeding dishes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Extra collar or harness as well as an extra leash
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bottled water, at least 7 days' worth for each person and pet
<input type="checkbox"/>	A traveling bag, crate or sturdy carrier, ideally one for each pet
<input type="checkbox"/>	Flashlight
<input type="checkbox"/>	Blanket (for scooping up a fearful pet)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Recent photos of your pets (in case you are separated and need to make "Lost" posters)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Especially for cats: Pillowcase, toys, scoopable litter
<input type="checkbox"/>	Especially for dogs: Extra leash, toys and chew toys, a week's worth of cage liner
