#### Notice to Employees Minimum Wage in Florida

The **2019 minimum wage in Florida** is **\$8.46** per hour, effective **January 1, 2019**,

with a minimum wage of at least \$5.44 per hour for tipped employees, in addition to tips. The minimum wage rate is recalculated yearly September 30, based on the Consumer Price Index.

An employer may not retaliate against an employee for exercising his or her right to receive the minimum wage. Rights protected by the State Constitution include the right to:

- 1. File a complaint about an employer's alleged noncompliance with lawful minimum wage requirements.
- 2. Inform any person about an employer's alleged noncompliance with lawful minimum wage requirements.
- 3. Inform any person of his or her potential rights under Section 24, Article X of the State Constitution and to assist him or her in asserting such rights.

#### HOUSING AND SHELTER



#### Hernando County's Point in Time Count is January 22, 2019

The Point in Time Count is an effort to learn more about the individuals and families experiencing a housing crisis. In order to accomplish

local and federal goals toward ending homelessness, it is important to know who is experiencing a housing crisis, where they are, and better understand the factors surrounding their housing situation.

Therefore, on **January 22**, **2019** community volunteers and agencies that work with the homeless are teaming up to count individuals and families in our community whose regular housing situation may not be suitable sleeping accommodations for humans, such as cars, parks, benches, abandoned buildings, woods, someone's backyard, garages, sheds, etc.

Part of the strategy for the unsheltered count is to conduct interviews at various locations that the homeless may visit like food pantries, hot meal sites, libraries, hospitals, etc.

Volunteers are needed. Training for volunteers will be held at the following location and time.

If you are not able to volunteer but would like to help; please consider contacting Mid Florida Homeless Coalition, **352-860-2308** to complete a Housing Survey or report to your information if the following occurs.

- You have information regarding individuals or families who lack a fixed regular nighttime residence;
- You have information on an individual or family whose primary nighttime residence is a public or private place not designed for sleeping accommodation of humans, such as a car, park, abandoned building, camping grounds, woods, someone's backyard, garage or shed, etc.;
- You are a faith based or charitable organization, federal, state, or local government program paying for someone to stay in a hotel or motel on January 22, 2019;
- You are interested in donating. All donations are welcomed; however, some suggestions include socks, chap stick, bug spray, personal hygiene items, gift cards, diapers, etc.

#### VETERAN SERVICES



**MOVE!** is a FREE weight management, health promotion program designed to improve the lives of Veterans.

The Weight Management Program is supported by VA's National Center of Health

Promotion and Disease Prevention (NCP). MOVE!'s core ideas - encouraging healthier eating behavior, increasing physical activity, and promoting even small weight losses are easy to follow and based on the latest in nutrition science. With the help of your MOVE! care team, you can reduce health risks, prevent or reverse certain diseases, improve your quality of life, and even live longer!

Every VA Medical Center has a dedicated MOVE! Coordinator who is available to assist you if you are interested in losing weight. Many VA Community –Base Outpatient Clinics offers MOVE! also.

There are many ways to participate in MOVE! However only veterans receiving care in the VA can enroll in the MOVE! Program.

#### To get started

- 1. Let your VA Primary Care Team know that you are interested in MOVE!.
- 2. Complete the MOVE!11 Getting Started Questionnaire to get personalized feedback on your current health status. It is an 11 item questionnaire that asks basic questions about your weight, health and prior attempts at weight loss and generates an individualized report that includes a list of recommended MOVE! handouts for you.
- 3. Print and Review your MOVE!11 Getting Started Questionnaire report with your team, who will help you set some initial goals.
- 4. With your teams guidance, chose from the MOVE! Treatment Options available at your facility.

Not A Veteran Receiving Care at the VA? No problem! MOVE! Handouts and MOVE! Coach mobile app are available to individuals interested in learning more about weight management.

#### **MOVE! Options of Care for Veterans include:**

- Move! Group Sessions Time limited, clinician-led groups;
- Move! Telephone Lifestyle Coaching One-on-one contact via telephone with coach;
- TeleMOVE!- Frequent reminders to stay on track that include daily interaction with in-home messaging technologies and clinician contact
- Move! Coach A mobile app for veterans who prefer to manage their weight on their own
- Weight Loss Medications and Bariatric Surgery—Veterans who have tried MOVE! But still struggle with weight management.


