

SAVE MONEY ON PROPERTY TAXES

Exemption applications will be accepted for the 2019 Tax Year until March 1, 2019. Applications submitted from March 2, 2018 to March 1, 2019 will be for the 2019 Tax Year.

Please keep in mind exemptions require an application, proof of income, disability and other documents. We have listed a few, but there are additional exemptions. For more information, contact your local property appraiser at **352-754-4190**. You can apply in person, by mail or online.

Low-Income Senior Exemption. Provides an additional Homestead Exemption of up to \$50,000. Must be 65 or older as of January 1, and your total household adjusted gross income may not exceed the annual income limit set by the Florida Department of Revenue. This limit is modified each year and generally released in January. This only applies to the property taxes levied by the Board of County Commissioners.

Long-Term Senior Resident Exemption. If you are a 25 year or longer resident on your property, you may be eligible for up to a \$250,000 exemption off county taxes. Your property must have a market value of less than \$250,000.

Widow/Widower Exemption. An Exemption of up to \$500 is available to any widow/widower who owns property in Hernando County and is a resident of Florida

Disability Exemption. An exemption of up to \$500 is available upon proper submission of information.

Combat-Related Disability Exemption For Seniors. Applicant must be 65 or older on January 1st, must be honorably discharge from military service and have a service connected disability of 10% or more that is combat related.

Fallen Hero Exemption. Any surviving spouse of a first responder who died in the line of duty while employed by the state or any political subdivision of the state, including authorities and special districts s exempt from ad-valorem taxes providing the deceased was a Florida resident as of January 1 or the year of first responder died.

Are You Still Recovering from Hurricane Irma???

Rebuild Florida is a program of the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), created to help Florida recover from the devastating impacts of Hurricane Irma. The first phase of Rebuild Florida is the Housing Repair Program, which will assist families to rebuild their homes that were damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Irma. The state of Florida is committed to helping homeowners affected by the storm by rebuilding or replacing damaged homes.

Rebuild Florida is a partnership of DEO and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which approved funding to local communities for Florida's long-term recovery efforts after the 2017 hurricane season. Rebuild Florida Housing Repair funds will help eligible homeowners impacted by Hurricane Irma and individuals and families from Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands displaced by Hurricane Maria. Rebuild Florida will repair and rebuild damaged homes across the hardest-hit communities of our state, with priority funding for those low-income residents who are most vulnerable, including the elderly, those with disabilities and families with children under the age of 18. PREGNANCY CONFIRMATION/ VERIFICATION AT NO COST TO YOU

A New Generation provides ultrasound services at no charge to you.

A pregnancy test is not conclusive and is insufficient to make a decision about your situation. Pregnancy tests respond to a hormone, HCG, released in your body when pregnant. However, up to 1/5 of all pregnancies end in natural miscarriage. HCG levels may remain high in your body, meaning for a period of time you will still test positive, but you may not have a viable pregnancy. Ultrasound, not urine or blood tests, is the fastest way to determine if you have a viable pregnancy.

Florida Ombudsmen Program - Advocating for Quality Long Term Care

Apply to become a state-certified volunteer longterm ombudsmen. In the state of Florida, a longterm care ombudsman is a trained volunteer who helps to improve the quality of care and life for residents of long-term care facilities such as nursing

homes, assisted living facilities, and adult family care homes.

According to Elder Affairs, nearly 60% of long-term care residents in Florida do not receive visits from family members or friends. Volunteer ombudsmen are community members, from all walks of life who care about improving the life for residents living in long term care facilities. They are trained to work with residents and their family members to communicate concerns and resolve problems by providing advocacy, support, education and empowerment.

Volunteer ombudsmen spend hours each year in licensed long-term care facilities, working to identify, investigate and resolve the concerns of residents and their loved ones, and performing annual assessment of every facility in Florida.

Ombudsmen also receive and investigate complaints on behalf of nursing home residents and their families and serves as a voice for residents ensuring that the facility meets mandated legal standards for every person receiving long-term services. ATTENTION SNAP CUSTOMERS

FLORIDA DEPARTMENT Due to the partial US Government Shutdown, SNAP customers who are not renewing in February will receive half of their

March benefits on March 1, 2019 and half on their regularly assigned day. If your renewal was approved by February 16th for the month of March, you will receive half of your benefits on March 1, 2019 and the other half on your regularly assigned day. If your renewal is approved on or after February 17, 2019 for the month of March, your case will be processed as usual and your full benefits for March will be available on the your regularly assigned day. New approved applications will be processed as usual and March benefits will be available on the assigned day. The assigned day will be stated on your approval notice in your MyACCESS Account. Remember to check your MyACCESS Account for the status of you case.

VA PROVIDES \$1 MILLION IN FUNDING FOR FLORIDA VETERANS SUPPORT LINE

To enhance veteran suicide prevention efforts, the <u>Crisis Center</u> of <u>Tampa Bay</u>, <u>U.S. Department</u> of <u>Veterans Affairs (VA)</u> and <u>Florida Department</u> of <u>Veterans</u>' Af-

<u>fairs (FDVA)</u> announced that the Crisis Center of Tampa Bay has received a \$1 million contract from the VA to enhance services provided to Florida veterans through the <u>Florida Veterans Support Line (1-844-MyFLVet)</u>.

Connecting veterans who are experiencing an emotional or mental health crisis with certified veteran counselors at **2-1-1** Centers across Florida can and will save lives.

The funding provides necessary resources to place veteran resource management staff and Veteran Peer Care Coordinators at local, non-profit organizations throughout Florida who answer calls from the Florida Veterans Support Line. Funding also provides technical assistance to those local organizations. Through veteran resource management staff, a database of VA and Non-VA community resources helpful to veterans will be created and maintained through this project.

Veteran Peer Care Coordinators provide follow-up, short-term support to veterans who call **1-844-MyFLVet (693-5838) and 2-1-1**. These veteran peers are able to easily relate to veteran callers because of similar life experiences that are unique to the veteran community.

The VA funding provides the next step in implementing a model of care for Florida's veterans modeled after the peer function of the national <u>Veterans Crisis Line</u> (1-800-273-8255 and press 1) and innovated for statewide use by the Crisis Center. The Crisis Center first launched the Florida Veterans Support Line in 2014 as a five-county pilot program. The Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs was instrumental in the launch of the program and continues to provide support in facilitating inter-agency collaboration for **1-844-MyFLVet**.


