ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

POLICY NO. 42-01

PURPOSE:

The Economic Development Technical Advisory Committee (EDTAC) shall act in an advisory capacity to the County's economic development staff regarding the Economic Development Program. The committee shall provide input, feedback and assistance on economic development issues such as strategic planning, goal setting, prioritization, policies, programming, investments, and incentives.

MEMBERSHIP:

- 1. The EDTAC members are recruited and appointed by the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) in accordance with Policy No. 06-01.
- 2. Membership of the EDTAC shall consist of seven to nine persons appointed by the BOCC; with specific areas of related professional or technical expertise. Areas of expertise may be comprised of but not limited to the following sectors: manufacturing/logistics, workforce, entrepreneur, education, healthcare, real estate, financial services, construction/development, community-based organization or association. Diversity of expertise should be retained as much as possible.
- 3. Members shall serve four-year staggered terms. It is required that members not serve more than two (2) four-year consecutive terms in accordance with Board of County Commissioners' Policy No. 06-01. Reappointment may only occur beyond the two-term limit if there is no new applicant available with the appropriate expertise.
- 4. Members shall meet a minimum of four times per year.
