HOUSING AND SHELTER

HOME REPAIR DO'S & DON'TS AFTER THE STORM

(Some Construction Contracting Do's and Don'ts recommendation by Community Legal Services of Mid Florida)

- **DO** ask to see the contractor's license and make sure it matches the person;
- **DO** determine how long the contractor has been in business;
- **DO** contact the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (1-850-487-2252) or www.myflorida.com to verify the current status of the license;
- DO ask for references and check them out;
- DO choose several contractors and get estimates from each; and
- **DO** get the agreement in writing read the contract, fill in all the blank spaces, make sure it contains the contractor's name, address, telephone number, license number, description of the work, completion date, and any warranty agreements.
- **DON'T** hire a contractor who requires advance payment arrange to pay upon completion or in installments;
- DON'T sign the work completion certificate until all the work is satisfactorily completed;
- DON'T pay cash; and
- DON'T pull the construction permits.

Watch Out for Scams!

Victims of Natural Disasters should take care not to be victimized a second time – by unscrupulous adjusters, contractors or retailers.

Verify that an adjuster is licensed by calling 1-800-227-8676.

Consumers should verify that a FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) or SBA (Small Business Administration) representative has a laminated photo ID card. A FEMA or SBA jacket or shirt is not proof of an affiliation.





Smoking Quitline

Tobacco quitlines can double your chance of quitting compared to getting no support at all. You are even more likely to be successful when you use a quitline and take smoking cessation medication.

Any Veteran receiving health care through VA is eligible to use the Quit Vet Quitline. Call 1-855-QUIT-VET (1-855-784-8838) to speak with a tobacco cessation counselor Monday-Friday. The quitline is closed on Federal holidays.

Counseling is available in English and Spanish.

Speak with a Quit VET Counselor and get:

- Help developing a quit plan
- Individualize counseling
- Strategies to prevent relapse
- Follow-up calls to help you stay quit

Your counselor may ask specific questions about your tobacco use, quitting history, and motivations to quit in order to help create a quit plan that works for you. Any information provided to the counselor during the call is kept private. It will not be shared with your VA health care provider or entered in your VA electronic medial record.

Your first call to 1-855-QUIT-VET will last about 15 to 30 minutes. Counselors are unable to provide smoking cessation medication to callers. Talk to your VA healthcare provider about using medication and let them know that you are using the Quit VET quit line.

Also consider SmokefreeVet, a free text messaging program to provide daily support, advice and encouragement. Sign up by texting the word VET to 47848 from your mobile phone or by visiting smokefree.gov/VET. For Spanish, text VETesp to 47848 or visit smokefree.gov/VETespanol.
