### 3. Transportation Disadvantaged Services Application – revision Draft

Citrus Transit is proposing to update the TD service application form by reducing the amount of information that is required on the form, reducing the number of pages from 2 to 1; Also, one (1) form will be applicable to one (1) person instead of one (1) household. Eligibility criteria remains unchanged.

To be eligible for TD services in Citrus County, one of the following criteria must be met:

- Income of \$1,200 or less per month,
- Age 60 and above
- Medicaid client
- Disabled

Changes to the eligibility criteria would require Citrus BOCC action.

**B APPROVAL/MODIFICATION OF AGENDA – Board/Staff comment only**

**C REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES – 2/11/2021**

**Motion:** Mr. Douglas made a motion to approve the February 11, 2021, minutes. It was second and the motion passed unanimously.

**D CORRESPONDENCE/INFORMATIONAL ITEMS**

**1. Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged (CTD)**

Mr. Diez stated one thing to note from the last CTD meeting on March 30, 2021, is that they did approve a new formula for the trip and equipment grant allocation. Anyone is welcome to attend the CTD meetings or watch them online.

**2. CTC designation process by July 1, 2022**

Mr. Diez stated Citrus County’s designation expires June 30, 2022, and the new 5-year designation process must be completed before July 1, 2022.

**3. Planning Agency Survey**

Mr. Diez reported that the Hernando/Citrus MPO (planning agency) is required to get annual surveys from this Board.

**4. LCB Vacancies**

Mr. Diez stated there is currently one vacancy on this Board and that is a representative from the State of Florida Children and Family Services.

**5. Transportation Disadvantaged Planning Grant FY 2021/2022**

Mr. Diez stated for informational purposes that the Planning Grant application for TD support services in the amount of \$23,076 was submitted.

**E ACTION ITEMS**

**1. Citrus County Transportation Disadvantaged Service Plan (TDSP) Annual Update**

Mr. Diez discussed that this is the annual update. He asked for questions or comments.

Ms. Davis Schlabach had a question on packet page 23, paragraph 1, why Homosassa was not included. Someone stated that was the orange line which was taken off about a year

ago due to low ridership. Ms. Davis Schlabach stated that 50 percent of our population was eligible and is there a reason why that population is not using the services. Homosassa is an area with a large population who qualify as “vulnerable”.

A discussion ensued on transit matters and that input from these Board members and/or their agencies, as well as the public would be helpful for Ms. Davis Schlabach to report to the Citrus BOCC.

A roll call vote for the Approval of the Transportation Service Plan Update was conducted and passed 10 - 0.

## **2. Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) Annual Evaluation**

The LCB members were provided the CTC Annual Evaluation and there were no comments or concerns.

### **F CITRUS COUNTY TRANSIT -- Joanne Granger**

#### **Quarterly report**

Discussion took place about the decline in ridership, that some board members take a ride on the bus services once they are fully operational again, bus service times and job services clients not being able to work because of gaps in bus schedules, etc.

Ms. Granger stated the Orange line is anticipated to be back in service by August. She also mentioned possibly reverting to transfer points where it is not counterintuitive; if you are using a 14 passenger bus for one customer, that bus is operating for 2 ½ hours serving only that one person. Smaller busses for a smaller number of riders would be more cost effective and efficient.

### **G KEY TRAINING CENTER – Theresa Flick**

Ms. Flick reported that they hope to resume activities June 1<sup>st</sup> just as they were like pre-COVID.
