Purpose

Data collection includes evaluation of the condition of the transportation network, as well as transportation related socio-economic and land use data. This task includes two (2) subtasks as described below:

2.1: Highway System Performance Surveillance

Purpose

To monitor traffic volume data, including link volumes and counts at major intersections. This information is used to evaluate the operating efficiency and condition of the existing classified transportation network, including the local and state-maintained systems.

Previous Work

Previous work includes various data collection activities related to the development of the Long Range Transportation Plan 2045 which included updates to the Congestion Management Process (CMP) and coordination with FDOT regarding District 7's activities with the Highway Performance Measuring System (HPMS). Traffic count data for Hernando and Citrus Counties was updated in 2020.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Department and the MPO on April 21, 2020 entered into a Metropolitan Planning Organization Agreement (Agreement), whereby the Department passed through Federal funds to the MPO to assist the MPO in performing transportation planning activities set forth in its Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed to modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants in this Amendment, the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 4 of the Agreement is amended to reflect:

Project Cost: The total budgetary ceiling for the Project is \$1,425,215. The budget, including tasks, is summarized below and detailed in the UPWP, Exhibit "A". The budget may be modified by mutual agreement as provided for in paragraph 7, Amendments.

The Department's performance and obligation to pay under this Agreement is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the Legislature. No work shall begin before the Agreement is fully executed and a "Letter of Authorization" is issued by the Department. The total of all authorizations shall not exceed the budgetary ceiling established for this agreement and shall be completed within the term of this Agreement:

Exhibit A (Scope of Work) of the Agreement is amended as follows: Unencumbering / de-obligating funds from FY 2021-2022 UPWP for use in FY 2023 (UPWP - Year 1). PL \$383,740. This action lowered the budgetary ceiling from \$1,808,955 to \$1,425,215. This amendment is more fully described in the attached UPWP Revision Form #6.

Except as modified, amended, or changed by this Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement and any amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.
