Dangerous Dog Classification

The canine listed below has been deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction a dangerous dog as defined in Florida Statute 767.11. For more information please review Chapter 767 in its entirety at flsenate.gov, Dangerous Dogs.

“Prince” resides at 4639 Keysville Ave., Spring Hill, FL 34608.



Notes for “Prince”

“Prince” was declared dangerous by the Hernando County Special Master on 4/14/20.

“Prince” is a 5-year-old black and white Siberian Husky. He is a neutered male weighing 90lbs, with microchip number 985112011273607 and has a current rabies vaccination until 4/5/24.

Prince is owned by Aaliyah Rivera who resides at: 4639 Keysville Ave., Spring Hill, FL 34608.

Prince was declared dangerous after two separate incidents wherein he attacked and killed two goats and one piglet. One of the goats was pregnant at the time, making her abort her kids. The first incident happened on December 20, 2022, when Prince was loose and attacked the neighbor’s chickens killing 9 of them. The second incident occurred on February 27, 2023, when he ran off property and attacked the neighbor’s goats and pigs. Both attacks occurred while he was running loose off property.

Proper caution should be used around this animal knowing he is highly animal aggressive and has a history of attacking other animals.
