Notes for “LADY”

“Lady” was declared dangerous by the Hernando County Special Master on 12/05/20.

“Lady” is an 6-year-old liver and white Pitbull Terrier mix. She is a spayed female weighing 72lbs, with microchip number 982126059988356 and has a current rabies vaccination until 10/01/24.

Lady is owned by Terran Curtis who resides at: 7095 Young St., Brooksville, FL 34601.

Lady was declared dangerous after two separate incidents wherein she attacked and killed two cats, both incidences happened on October 8th, 2020. Both attacks occurred while she was running loose off property.

Proper caution should be used around this animal knowing he is highly animal aggressive and has a history of attacking other animals.
