Clear-sight triangle: (1) Driveway: A clear-vision triangle of property on each side of a driveway formed by the intersection of the driveway edge, the street right-of-way line, and a third line connecting the two. Clear-vision distances are ten (10) feet along the driveway edge and twenty (20) feet along the street right-of-way line. (2) Street/railroad intersection: A clear-vision triangle of property formed by two (2) intersecting right-of-way lines and a third line connecting the two, as provided in the Hernando County Facilities Guidelines. The right-of-way line may be either for a street or a railroad.

Applicant agrees and understands that this permit is for _____ days from “Effective Date”, and failure to comply will cause this affidavit to be considered a Notice of Violation pursuant to Section 162.21, Florida Statutes, as it may be amended from time to time and will allow Hernando County to have issued, by a Code Enforcement Officer, a citation for violation of a Hernando County code provision without the necessity of allowing the applicant any period of time to correct the violation. Applicant understands that the issuance of a citation may subject applicant to civil penalties permitted by law.
