

Water Usage Facts

- One day per week watering restrictions was enacted July 27, 2010, through Hernando County Ordinance No. 2010-15.
- Hernando County Code Enforcement does not provide warnings for water violations.
- Fines are as follows:
 - \$100 for first offense
 - \$500 for second offense
 - Mandatory court hearing for third offense
- One day per week water restrictions apply to everyone who irrigates their landscape. This includes **ALL** sources of water, such as but not limited too, private wells, rivers, lakes, springs, canals, and water utilities (Hernando County Utilities Department).
