## MARINE PATROL REPORT - Deputy Steve Snell

Deputies provided the following updates/information:

- Additional officer assisting over the summer has ended. Back to three marine deputies.
- HCSO is budgeting for a fourth marine deputy for FY 25.
- SPZ six-month education period ends October 2024. A ticket may be issued for failure to abide by the SPZ rule. SPZ citation is \$140.
- FWC has nine officers covering Hernando County. They assist with enforcing rules on our waterways, which includes the SPZ.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

WAC Meeting location and time.

- Date, time, and location of all WAC meetings for calendar year 2025 were presented.
  - Kathryn Birren made a motion to approve. Seconded by Ron Zellmer. Approved unanimously.
- 2. WAC vacancy.
  - Two applications were received. An applicant will be selected at the BOCC meeting on 8/13/2024.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- 3. Weeki Wachee River Dredge
  - SWFWMD reports dredge activities are on schedule and should be completed by October 2024.
  - County is in discussions with multiple agencies/organizations to conduct vegetation restoration within the river.

#### INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

- 4. Jenkins Creek Spring run restoration
  - Working with FWC and UF/IFAS Extension Office to identify tasks needed to be addressed to better support manatee population.
- 5. Bendickson Reef deployment
  - County staff with assistance from our consultant (Reef Innovations) deployed additional reef material between tanks 3 and 5.
- 6. Replacement of old/faded signs
  - County staff will be replacing old, faded, and damaged signs on coastal and inland waterbodies as needed.
- 7. Weeki Wachee Preserve Park
  - The County is working with a consultant on phase one activities which include: access bridge, informational kiosk, restrooms, and an Education/Recreation Management Plan.

### **CITIZENS' COMMENTS**

The following citizens commented as follows:

- How can educational signs be placed on the Weeki Wachee River? Specifically, manatee awareness/information signs.
- Are the WAC meetings posted on the County Facebook page with all pertinent information listed (date, time, location)?
  - Yes.
- What agency conducts water quality sampling on Weeki Wachee River? Concern noted was the discharge from property adjacent to Big Cypress Canal.
  - o Contact DEP's DEAR section.

  - UF/IFAS Extension Office conducts water quality sampling monthly.
- Where is the Ecoharvester vessel?
  - Due to depressed water levels currently, the County is unable to launch the vessel safely.
     Water levels are being continuously monitored.
- Is it possible to have SWFWMD, DEP, SeaGrant Agent at the next meeting to address concerns about water quality and discharge from property?
  - A meeting notification is sent to these agencies prior to each WAC meeting.
